**SETTING:**

Indoor or outdoor, playground, streets, etc

**DESCRIPTION OF THE GAME:**

At least 5 players make a circle and every player has a friend behind him/her, making it two circles.

There is a chaser who tries to catch the runner.

**RULES:**

Two players, who are out of the circle, are the chaser and the runner. The runner can stand in front of one of the pairs, and the third party in the round, must run quickly, and now he is the runner.

The round ends when the chaser catches the runner, and the runner becomes the catcher in the next round.
